



Downtown Walnut Creek's New Mini-Plaza on North Main Street

Walnut Creek, CA. (August 27, 2019) - This summer the City of Walnut Creek will be undertaking construction of the Cypress Mini-Plaza Project. This project is a public-private partnership between the City and Walnut Creek Downtown (WCD), which will enhance the public sidewalk area aesthetically on the west side of North Main Street, extending north from DiMaggio's Barber Shop (1379 N. Main Street) to Cypress Street.

The project will reconstruct the sidewalk within the area, and add new hardscape, landscaping, arbor, seating, parklet and synthetic surface mounds, as well as other amenities. The space will provide a gathering space that will positively impact the downtown businesses.

The partnership between the City and Walnut Creek Downtown to provide this beautification project has been four years in the making. "The City looks forward to providing a community gathering space that will aesthetically enhance the heart of our downtown," commented Mayor Cindy Silva.

Construction began on August 14 and the project will be completed in late Fall. Affected businesses will remain open during construction.

TNB Construction is the project's contractor and BASE Landscape Architecture is the project architect.
